





The Pro League identifies priorities on UEFA Club Competitions

On Monday 5 August, the Clubs of Belgium Pro League discussed the proposals for the reform of European Club Competitions 2024 onward presented by UEFA and supported by the European Club Association (ECA).

As result, the Belgian Pro League Board of Directors has instructed the league management to prepare a note, which will be sent via the European Leagues to UEFA, to highlight the following priorities:

- Additional spots for Belgian clubs following the extension of European competitions with the creation of the Europa League 2.
- Limitation of the number of European matches: weekend matches are exclusively reserved for national competitions.
- Guarantee of at least 1 direct access for Belgian clubs for UCL and UEL1.
- Participation in European competitions must be defined on the basis of the results obtained in the domestic competitions: it is out of the question to provide permanent places in the Champions League or the UEL1.
